Smart Fuel Management Tip #1:

Make your fuel supply a priority BEFORE an emergency; your fuel supply is a critical component to the success of your fleet and business.

Question: What is the formula to monitor my resources?

Planning for an emergency means that amount (above) must be available 24/7 in addition to your operational needs.

If you have your emergency supply separate from your operational supply, it's imperative you roll it to assure it's ready when needed.

Question: Do you have storage resources for your emergency fuel supply, plus your operational needs?

Question: Does your fuel supplier work with you to develop customized fuel management solutions?

Question: Are you monitoring your tanks during operational times?
